

Re: Smaller Trash Carts

Dear Palmyra Resident,

As you are aware the Borough has been distributing 95-gallon and 64-gallon trash carts to residents as part of our new automated trash collection system. This system is designed to help keep our community clean and save money.

Knowing in advance that 95-gallon carts may have been too large for some residents we offered smaller 64-gallon carts as well. Now that they've been distributed some residents have asked for even smaller carts.

In an effort to accommodate our senior citizens and disabled residents, and residents of the Riverfront community, the Borough is making 32-gallon carts available on a limited basis.

You qualify for the smaller 32-gallon cart if you or your spouse or Civil Union Partner are:

- 65 or more years of age; OR
- permanently and totally disabled; OR
- a disabled veteran.

You are also entitled to the smaller 32-gallon cart if you live in the Riverfront community.

If you would like to have the smaller 32-gallon cart please complete and return the enclosed postcard by August 2, 2013. (Please remember to add a stamp -- we apologize that we are not able to provide postage-paid postcards). Please note that it'll take approximately 4 weeks to receive the new carts once the order is placed.

Once we receive the 32-gallon carts, we'll make arrangements to deliver it to your residence and exchange it for your current cart. Please note that the 32-gallon carts are considerably smaller than either the 95-gallon or 64-gallon models (they're about the size of a standard trash can), and measure about 36" tall.
