 Carbon Monoxide (CO) detectors
Carbon Monoxide (CO) Detectors shall be installed and maintained in the immediate vicinity of the sleeping area(s) and must be located within 10 feet of those areas.
 Smoke Detectors
Smoke Detectors must be installed and maintained on each level of the premises including the basement and the attic (even if unfinished) if there are walk-up steps. Smoke Detectors are required outside of each separate sleeping area and must be located within 10 feet of those areas. Smoke Detectors shall not be located in the kitchen.

Note a:

Combined living room and dining room spaces shall comply with the requirements above if the total area is equal to that required for separate rooms and if the space is located so as to function as a combination living room/dining room.

Area for sleeping purposes (Section PM-405.3)

Every room occupied for sleeping purposes by one *occupant* shall contain at least 70 square feet of floor area, and every room occupied for sleeping purposes by more than one *person* shall contain at least 50 square feet of floor area for each *occupant* thereof.
