365 days a year, your neighbors, the members of the Palmyra-Cinnaminson-Riverton Emergency Medical Services provide you with the highest quality pre-hospital care in your time of need. However, once a year we need to ask you for financial support. All Contributions and Donations from our fund drive will be used to fund the 2013 budget. Until the year 2000, we remained an all-volunteer service. Times have changed and it became necessary to hire part-time Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT's) to help cover all shifts and ensure prompt service. We provide Emergency Medical Services to residents of the Tri-Boro communities 24 Hours a Day, 7 Days a Week with a combination of Part-time Paid and Volunteer Staff. Unfortunately, hiring a Part-time Paid Staff, along with the rising cost of fuel, daily expenses, and equipment caused us to exceed our normal operating budget. This necessary expense enables us to serve you better, but now we need your financial assistance more than ever. We hope you can be as generous as you have in the past.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Palmyra-Cinnaminson-Riverton Emergency Medical Services (PCR/EMS) provides the highest quality pre-hospital care to the residents of the Tri-Boro area 24 hours a day.
- PCR/EMS responded to approximately 2500 calls in 2012.
- PCR/EMS organizes American Red Cross blood drives at our station on a quarterly basis.
- PCR/EMS maintains a limited inventory of wheelchairs, crutches, and walkers for the residents of the communities we serve. Loan of this equipment can be arranged by contacting our station.
- PCR/EMS is always looking for volunteers. Not only do we need EMT's, but we also need volunteers to assist us in helping in other ways such as building maintenance, legal services and office work. Please check the appropriate box on the return card for more information.

CPR revised guidelines: Think C-A-B

COMPRESSIONS

Push at least 2 inches on adult breastbone, 100 times per minute, to move oxygenated blood to vital organs



AIRWAY

Open the airway and check for breathing or blockage; watch for rise of chest and listen for air movement



BREATHING

Tilt chin back for the unobstructed passing of air; give two breaths and resume chest compressions



NOTE: Those untrained in CPR can simply do chest compressions until help arrives.
