

I hope this letter finds you well.

Palmyra Mayor Karen A. Scheffler, Esq., and the members of Palmyra's Borough Council have instructed me to contact Willingboro Animal Control regarding a serious problem with feral cats that we're experiencing in several locations in the Borough. We are especially concerned considering the potential public health threat posed to children and pets by rabies.

We request a meeting with your Animal Control Office to determine how best to reduce the feral cat population in our community and minimize any health threats to our residents. We are actively citing individuals who we know to be feeding these animals but that alone is insufficient to resolve the problem. Trapping, by individual residents and Public Works personnel, has also proved ineffective.
