
**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PALMYRA AMENDING
THE SEWER USAGE RATES AND CONNECTION FEES.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 215. Sewers, of the Code of the Borough of Palmyra ("Code") sets forth, inter alia, the usage rates and connection fees applicable to buildings or facilities connected to the Borough's sewerage system, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Palmyra, County of Burlington, New Jersey, as follows:

1. Section § 215-5. Service charges, shall be revised per attached Schedules A, B, C & D.
2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.

Chapter 215. Sewer, of the Code of the Borough of Palmyra

§ 215-5. Service charges.

A. Schedule A: Residential Units – Nonindustrial Waste.

Add the following:

Every person, a citizen and resident of the Borough of Palmyra of the age 65 years or older as of January 1st of the billing year, for their primary residence only, shall be given a credit of \$20.00.

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§ 215-5. Service charges.

B. Schedule B: Public and Commercial Buildings - Nonindustrial Waste. For each of the following:

Delete in its entirety and replace with the following:

USE Commercial uses including but not limited to:

Churches

Professional offices, retail business stores or shops

Garage and filling stations without car wash

Restaurants and caterers, fast-food takeout

Banks and financial institutions

Business and alcoholic consumption

Beauty salons and barbershops

Post office

Funeral homes

Bowling alleys

Automobile dealerships, with showroom

Automobile dealerships, without showroom

Lodges and clubs

Bridge complexes

Other commercial properties

ANNUAL RATE

Base Rate of \$600.00 annually plus Additional Fees for annual water usage calculated using semi-annual water usage (water utility billing periods from mid-September to mid-February inclusive; known as Measurement Period) as provided by New Jersey American Water Company.

Base Rate of \$600.00 includes up to 20,000 gallons of water used during Measurement Period.

Additional Fees are calculated as follows:

\$9.28 for every 1000 gallons used from 20,001 to 35,000 gallons used during Measurement Period.

\$9.78 for every 1000 gallons used from 35,001 to 50,000 gallons used during Measurement Period.

\$10.28 for every 1000 gallons used over 50,000 gallons used during Measurement Period.

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§ 215-5. Service charges.

- C. **Schedule C: Industrial Establishments Without Industrial Waste as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.2 and/or a Significant Indirect User Permit issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.**

Delete in its entirety and replace with the following:

ANNUAL RATE

Base Rate of \$1200.00 annually plus Additional Fees for annual water usage calculated using semi-annual water usage (water utility billing periods from mid-September to mid-February inclusive; known as Measurement Period) as provided by New Jersey American Water Company.

Base Rate of \$1200.00 includes up to 20,000 gallons of water used during Measurement Period.

Additional Fees are calculated as follows:

\$9.28 for every 1000 gallons used from 20,001 to 35,000 gallons used during Measurement Period.

\$9.78 for every 1000 gallons used from 35,001 to 50,000 gallons used during Measurement Period.

\$10.28 for every 1000 gallons used over 50,000 gallons used during Measurement Period.

§ 215-5. Service charges.

- D. Schedule D: Industrial Establishments With Industrial Waste as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.2 and/or a Significant Indirect User Permit issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.**

Delete paragraph (2) in its entirety and replace with the following:

- (2) Base Rate of \$1200.00 plus Additional Fees for treatment and disposal of factory effluents or industrial wastes as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.2 and/or for a Significant Indirect User Permit issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, is hereby established at the following rate schedule:

\$9.28 for every 1000 gallons from 20,001 to 35,000 gallons.

\$9.78 for every 1000 gallons from 35,001 to 50,000 gallons.

\$10.28 for every 1000 gallons over 50,000 gallons.

In addition, provisions of **§ 215-9. Limitations on wastewater discharges**, remain in effect.
