AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 90-8.2 OF
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PALMYRA AND REMOVING ORDINANCE
2011-3 FROM CHAPTER 237 OF THE CODE AND RELOCATING ORDINANCE 2011-3 IN
CHAPTER 90-8.2

Ordinance No. 2015-6

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2011-3 titled An Ordinance of the Borough of Palmyra Amending and Supplementing Chapter 237, Article III of the Borough Code was adopted in March of 2011 (the "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance deleted and repealed the then existing Chapter 237-17 of the Borough Code and replaced it with a new Chapter 237-17 titled "Temporary parking prohibition during snow plowing and removal" and

WHEREAS, the new Chapter 237-17 contained a repealer clause, but did not explicitly refer to Chapter 90-8.2 of the Borough Code titled "Snow emergency parking" and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid any confusion to the public and to make the Code more "user friendly"

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Palmyra, in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Chapter 90-8.2 of the Borough Code is hereby deleted and repealed in its entirety.
2. The Ordinance 2011-3 creating the new Chapter 237-17 titled "Temporary parking prohibition during snow plowing and removal" shall be removed from Chapter 237 of the Code and relocated in Chapter 90-8.2.

REPEALER: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication according to law.
