Wintry weather will affect the area late Thursday night and early Friday.

Hazards:

Snow: Snow will develop across eastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delmarva during the evening hours Thursday, generally after the evening commute, then continue through the overnight hours. Accumulations of up to 2 inches across eastern Pennsylvania and northern New Jersey are expected by morning, with 2 to 3 inches expected across central and southern New Jersey and Delmarva. The snows will taper off in most areas by the Friday morning commute, but may linger a bit longer across the coastal areas of New Jersey.

Outlook:

Another snow event is possible across Delmarva and New Jersey on Saturday. This storm is currently forecast to track far enough to our south and east to spare us from significant impacts. However, it's still a possibility that this may become a more significant event if the storm track shifts even slightly closer to the area. Temperatures will become gradually colder through the end of the week, with sub-freezing temperatures expected from Friday night through Monday.

Impacts:

Hazardous travel conditions are possible Thursday night and early Friday.





