§ 74-9. Timely licensing of incoming dogs.

Any person who shall bring a dog into this Borough from another state shall apply for a license and registration tag for said dog within 90 days after it is brought into this Borough if it is registered in such other state and within 10 days if it is not registered in such other state. The owner of any newly acquired dog of licensing age or of any dog which attains licensing age shall make applications for and procure a license and registration tag for such dog within 10 days after acquisition or age attainment.

- A. "Dog of licensing age" shall be any dog which has attained the age of seven months or which possesses a set of permanent teeth.
- B. There shall be no adjustment of the license or registration fee for licenses or registration tags issued and valid for a fractional portion of the license.

STATE REGULATIONS:

1. The duration of immunity as reflected on the rabies certificate should extend throughout the period for which a license is being issued; however, dogs with a duration of immunity that expires before the end of the license period are considered acceptable for licensing, provided the expiration date is no more than two months prior to the end of the license period. Dogs with a duration of immunity for rabies which expires more than two months prior to the end of the licensure period should be boosted prior to the issuance of a license.
