AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 195 OF THE CODE TO ESTABLISHING NEW PENALTIES INCLUDING FINES AND INCARCERATION

Ordinance No. 2013-19

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Palmyra, in the County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Chapter 195 of the Code of the Borough of Palmyra shall be amended as follows:

Section 8 entitled "Violations and Penalties" shall be replaced with the following:

VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

For the first offense of violating the provisions of this chapter, the minimum fine shall be \$200.00 and up to \$1,000.00 and incarceration up to 90 days in the county jail

For the second offense of violating the provisions of this chapter, the minimum fine shall be \$500.00 and up to \$1,000.00 and incarceration up to 120 days in the county jail.

For a third or subsequent offense of violating the provisions of this chapter, the minimum fine shall be \$1,000.00 and incarceration up to 180 days in the county jail.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication according to law.
