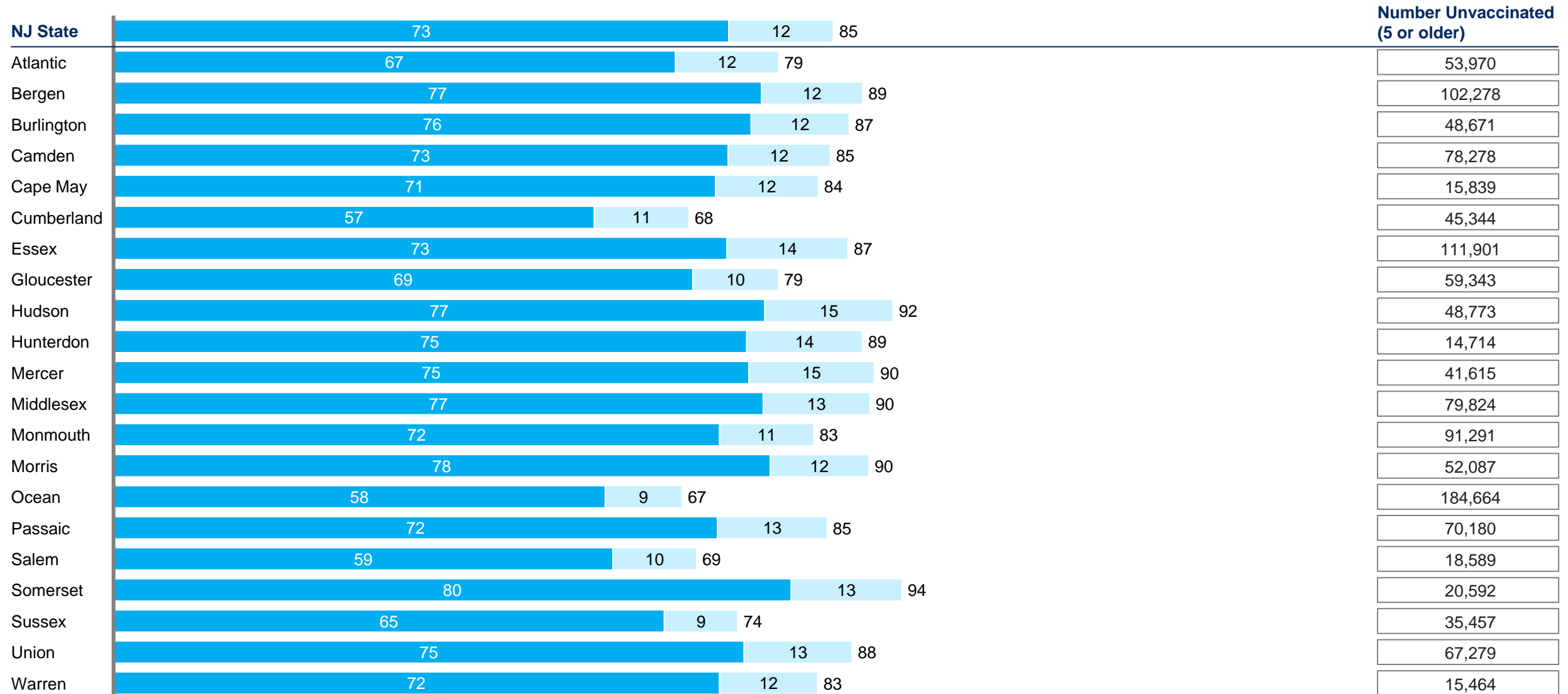

State-wide vaccine courses for 5+ year old patients (%)



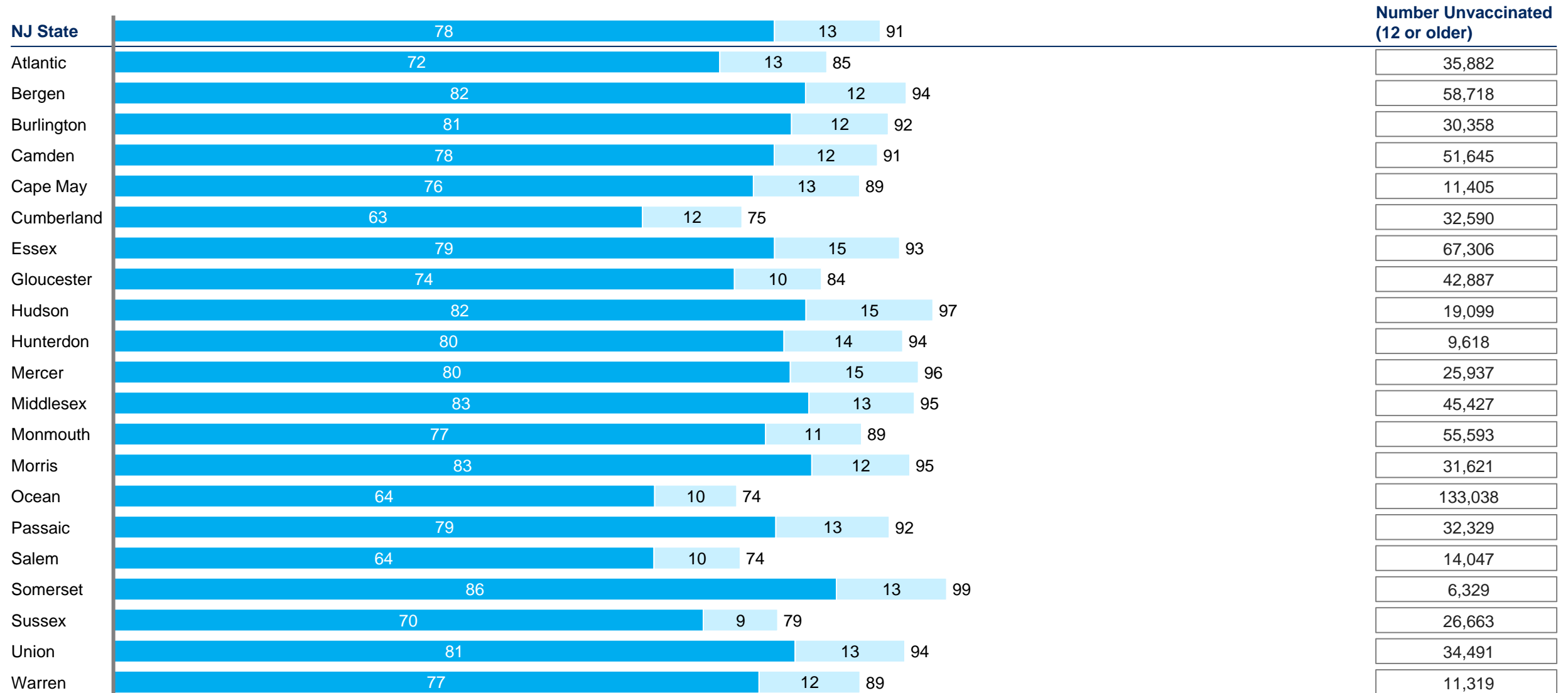

State-wide vaccine courses for 12+ year old patients (%)



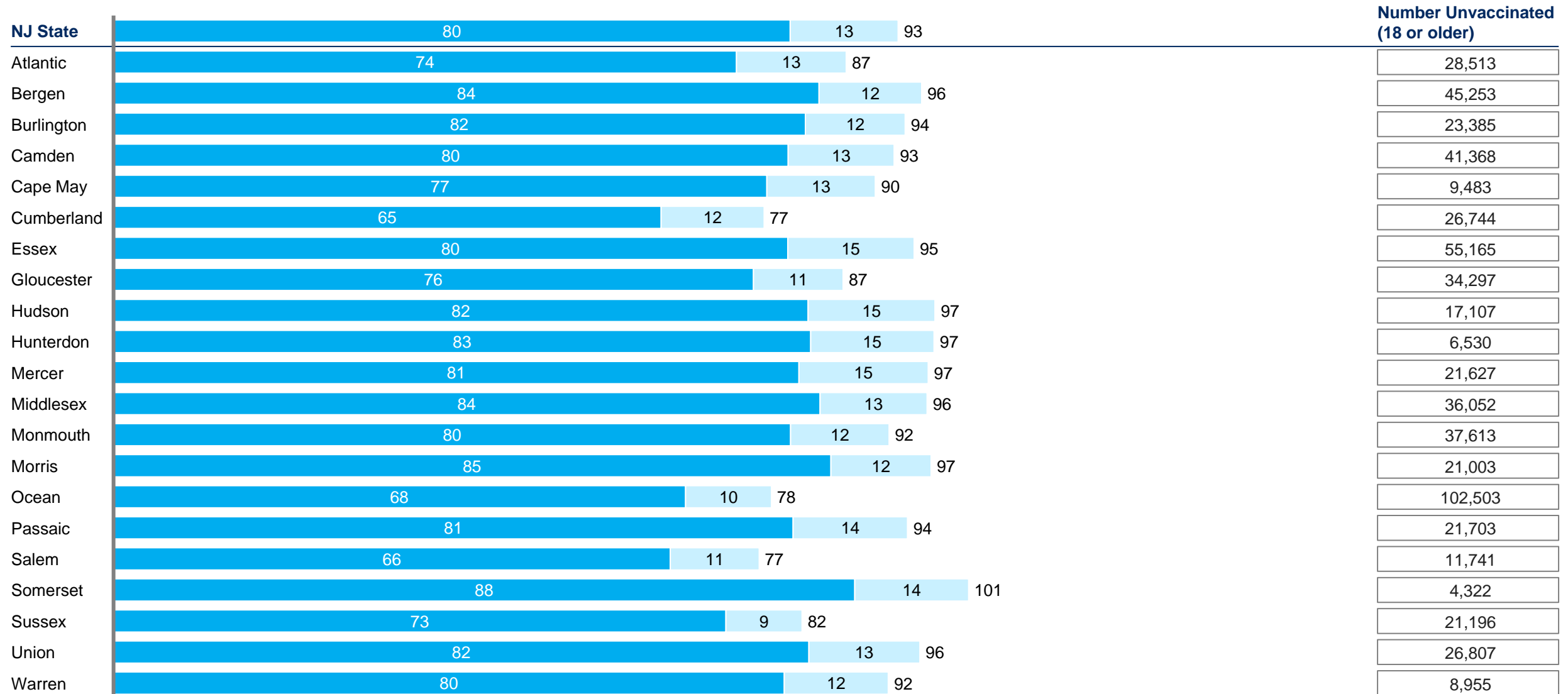

State-wide vaccine courses for 18+ year old patients (%)



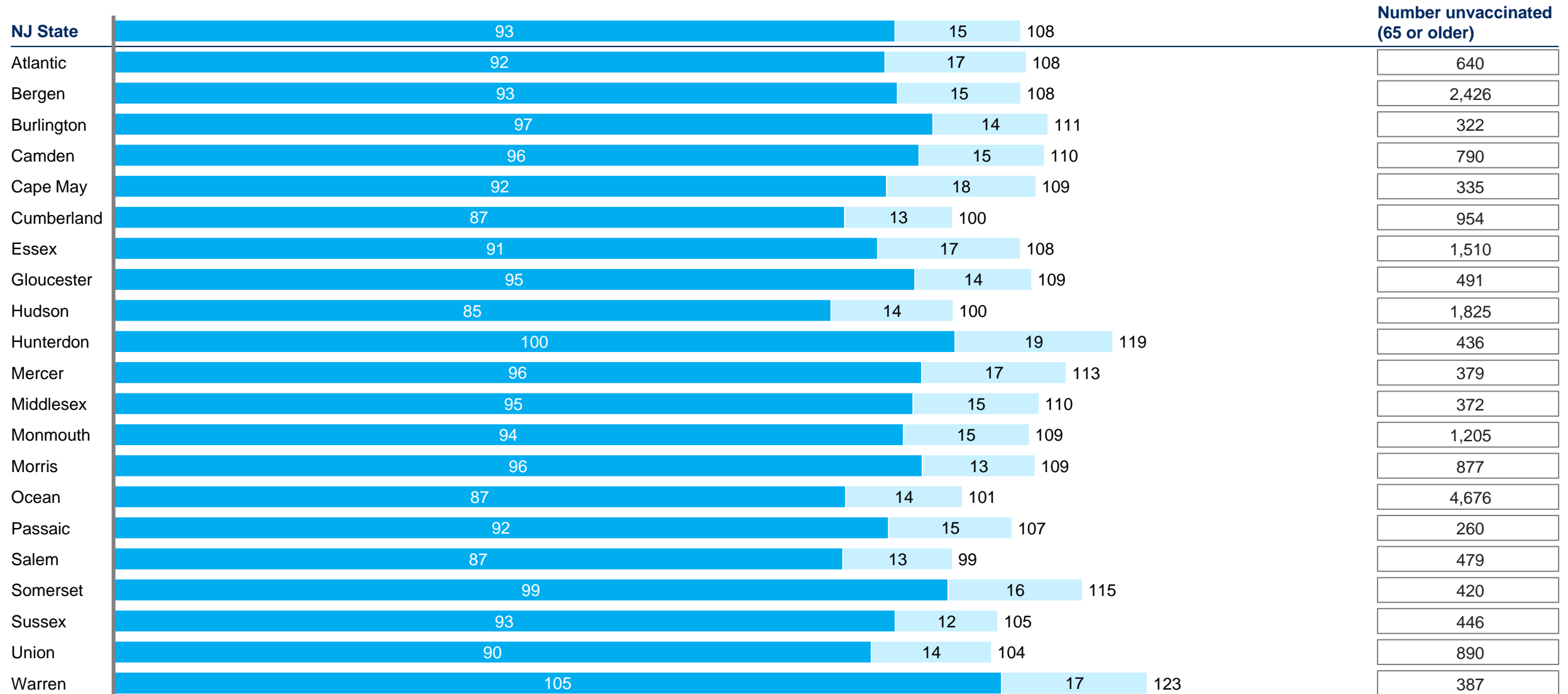

State-wide vaccine courses for 5-11 year old patients (%)



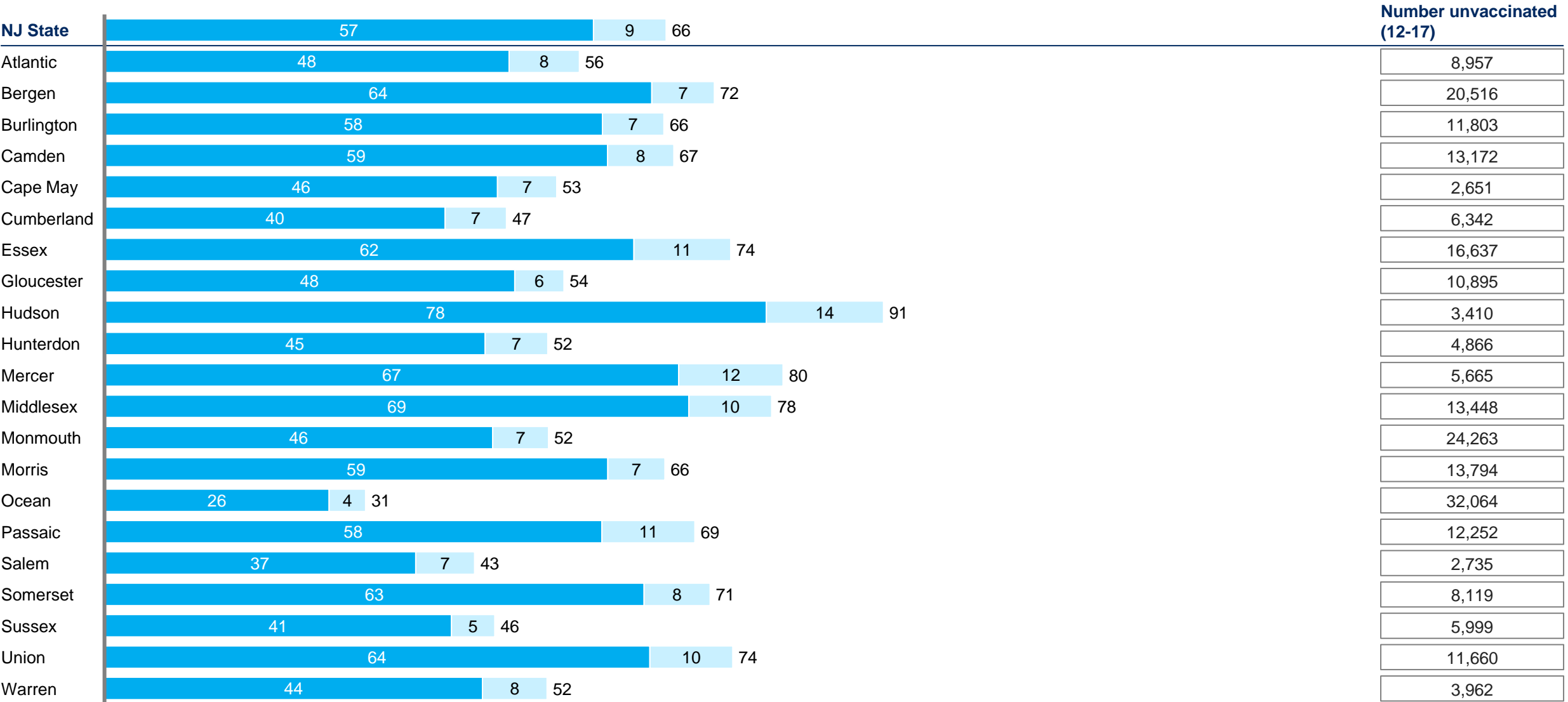

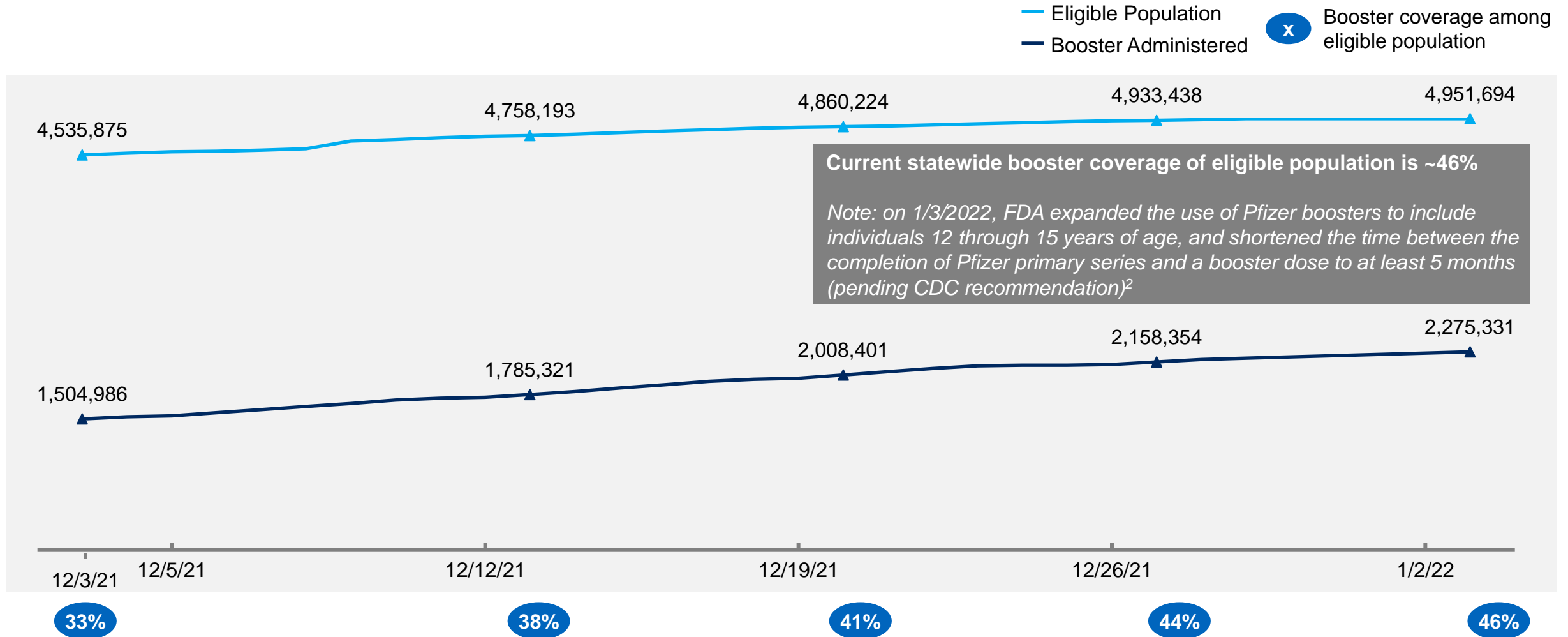

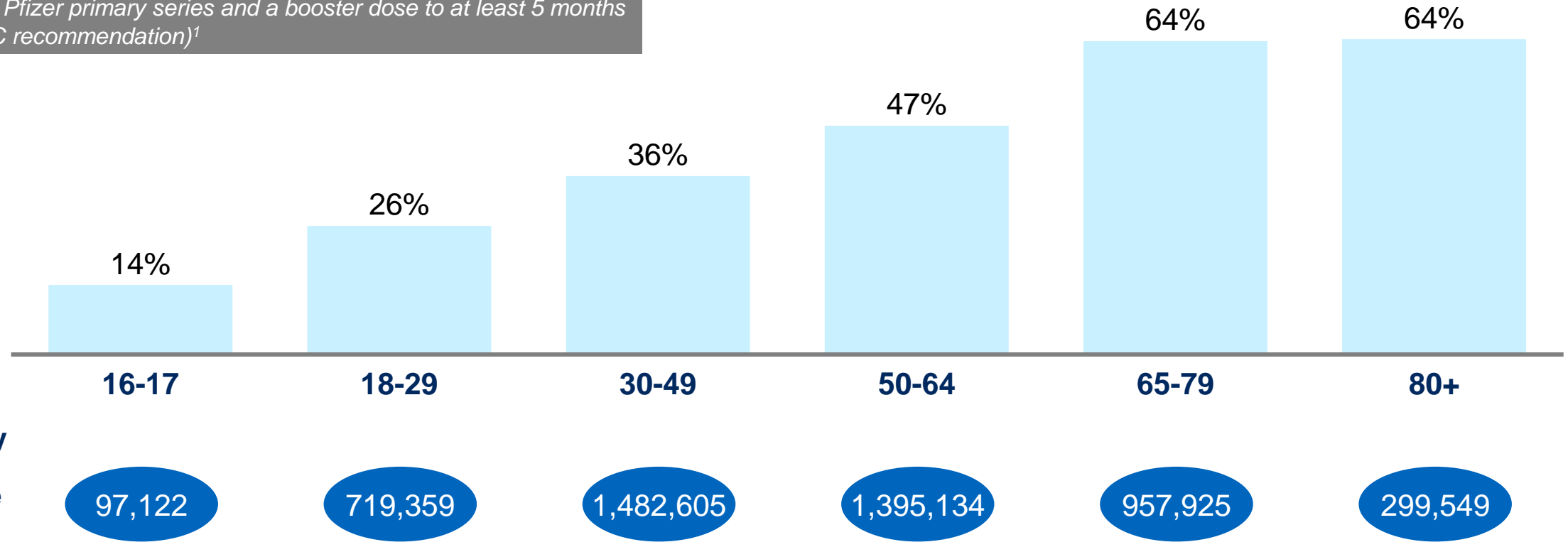

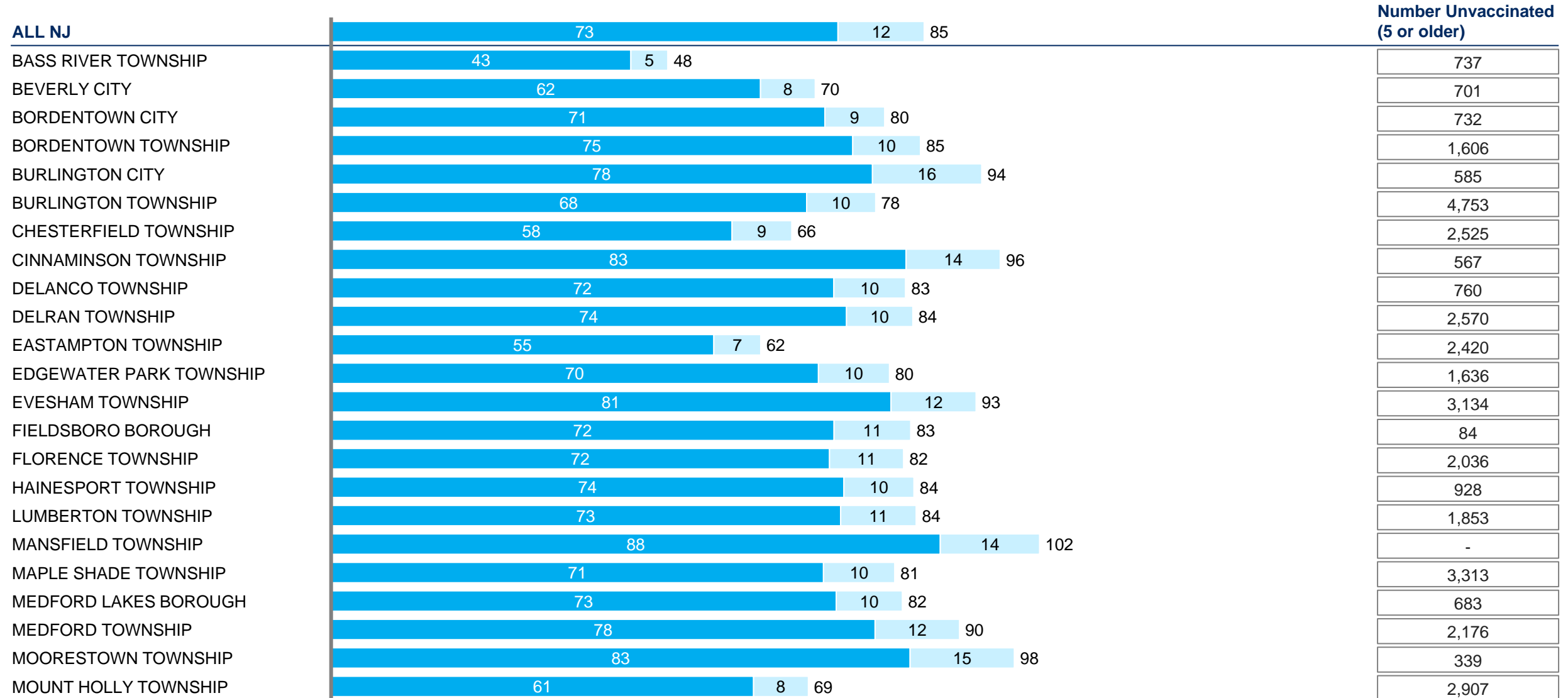

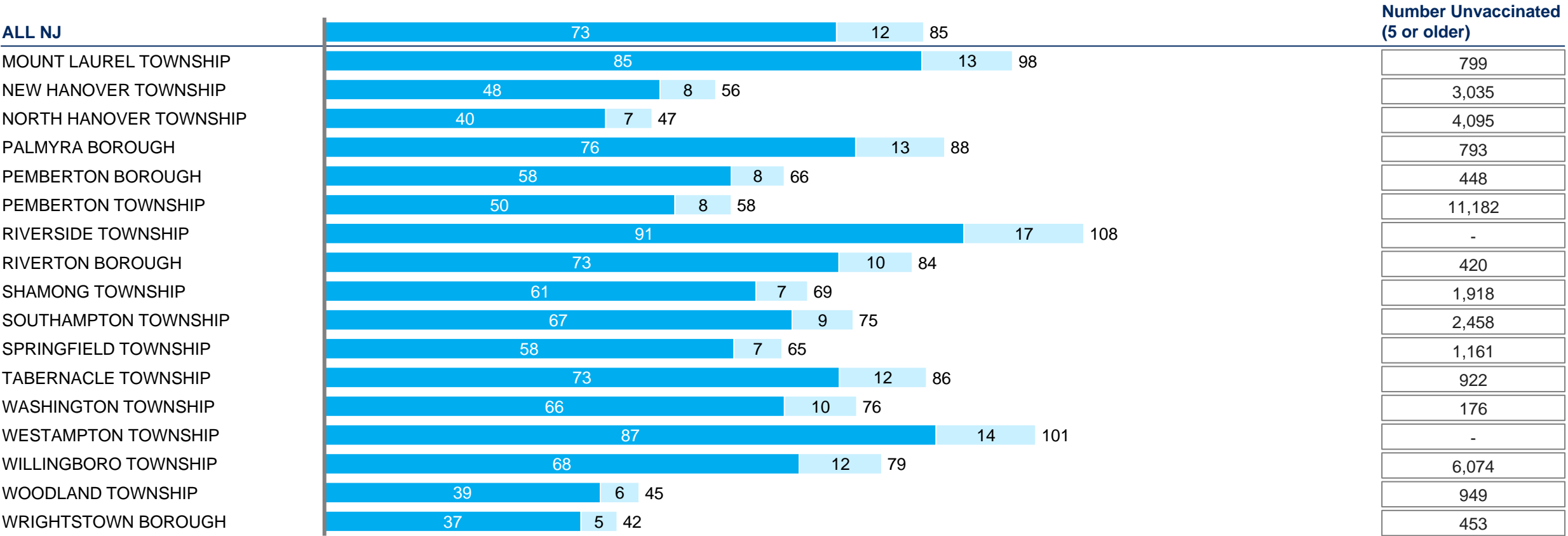

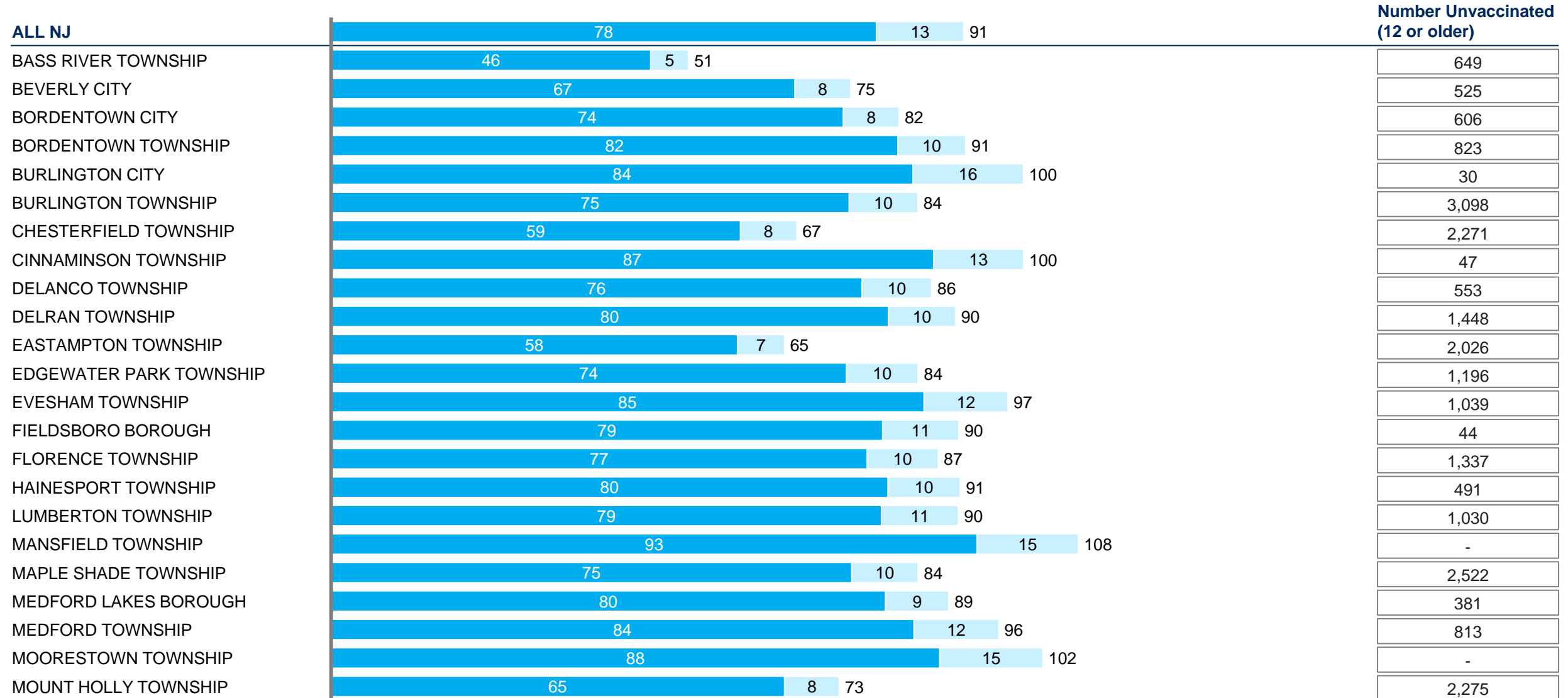

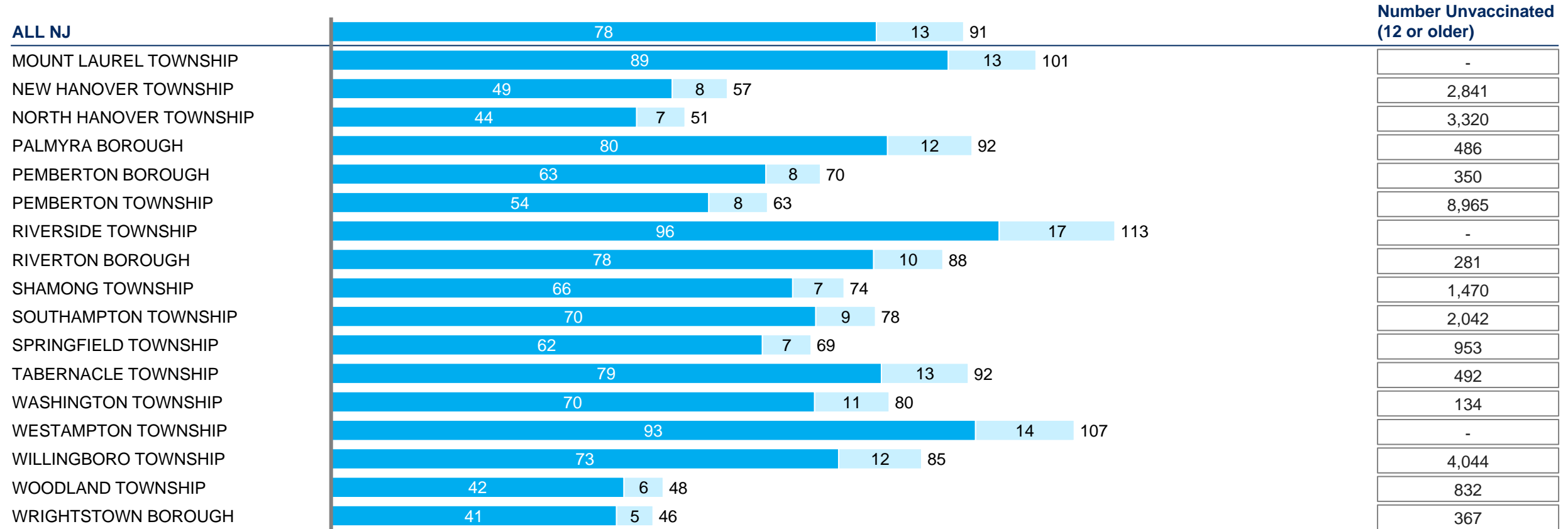
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Vaccine coverage for 12+ year old patients in municipalities within Burlington county (2/2)

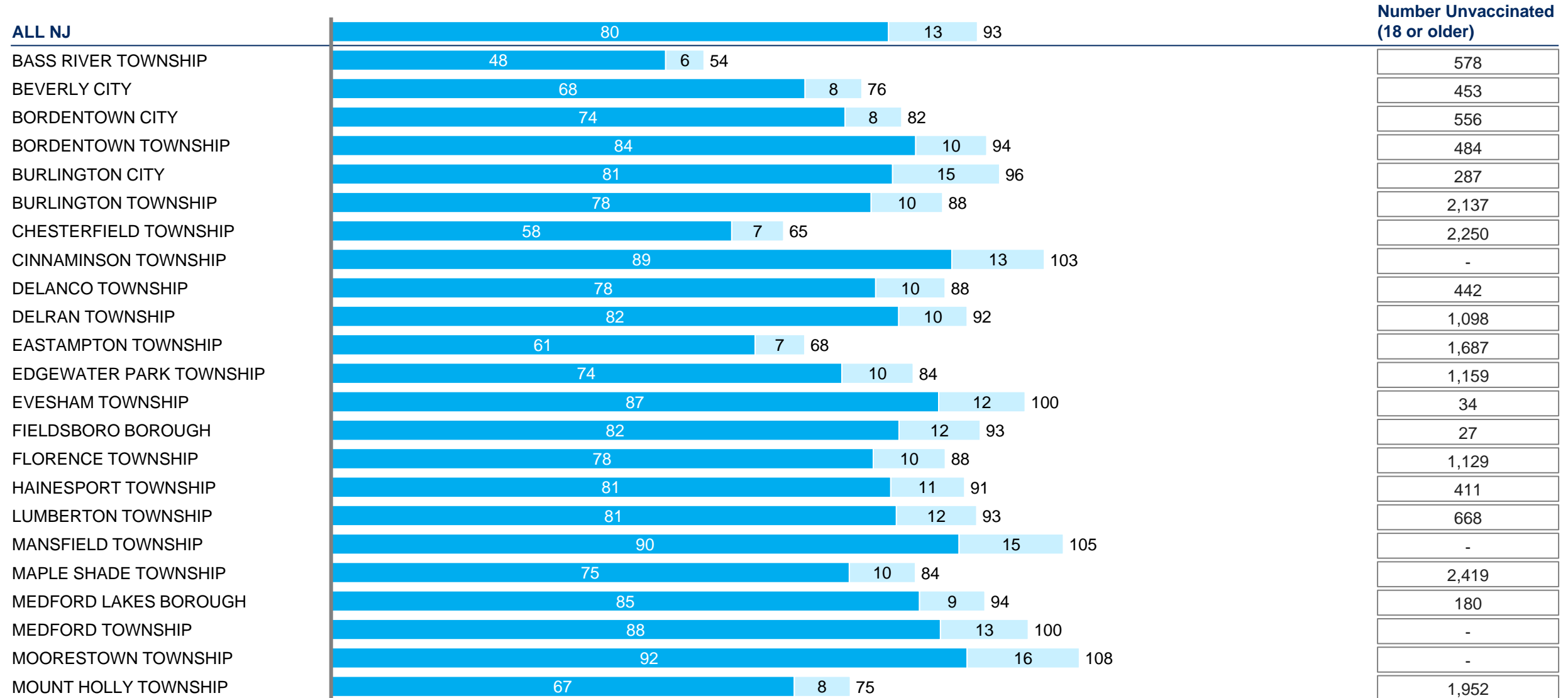
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Vaccine coverage for 18+ year old patients in municipalities within Burlington county (1/2)

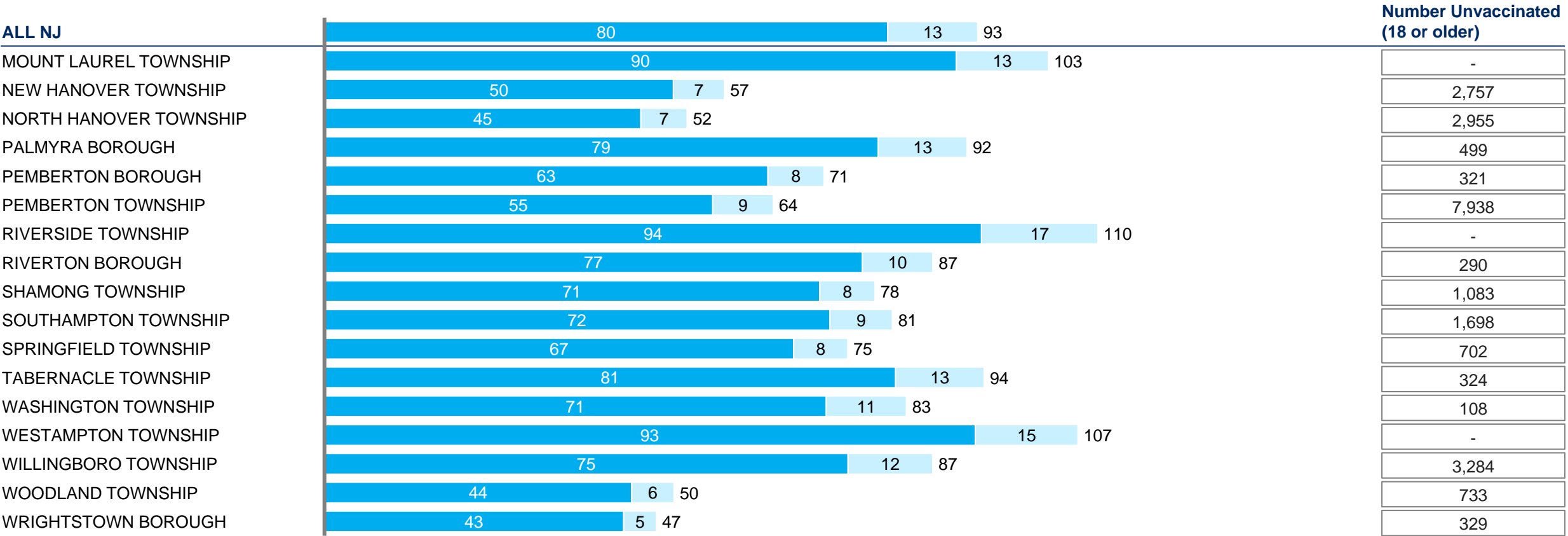

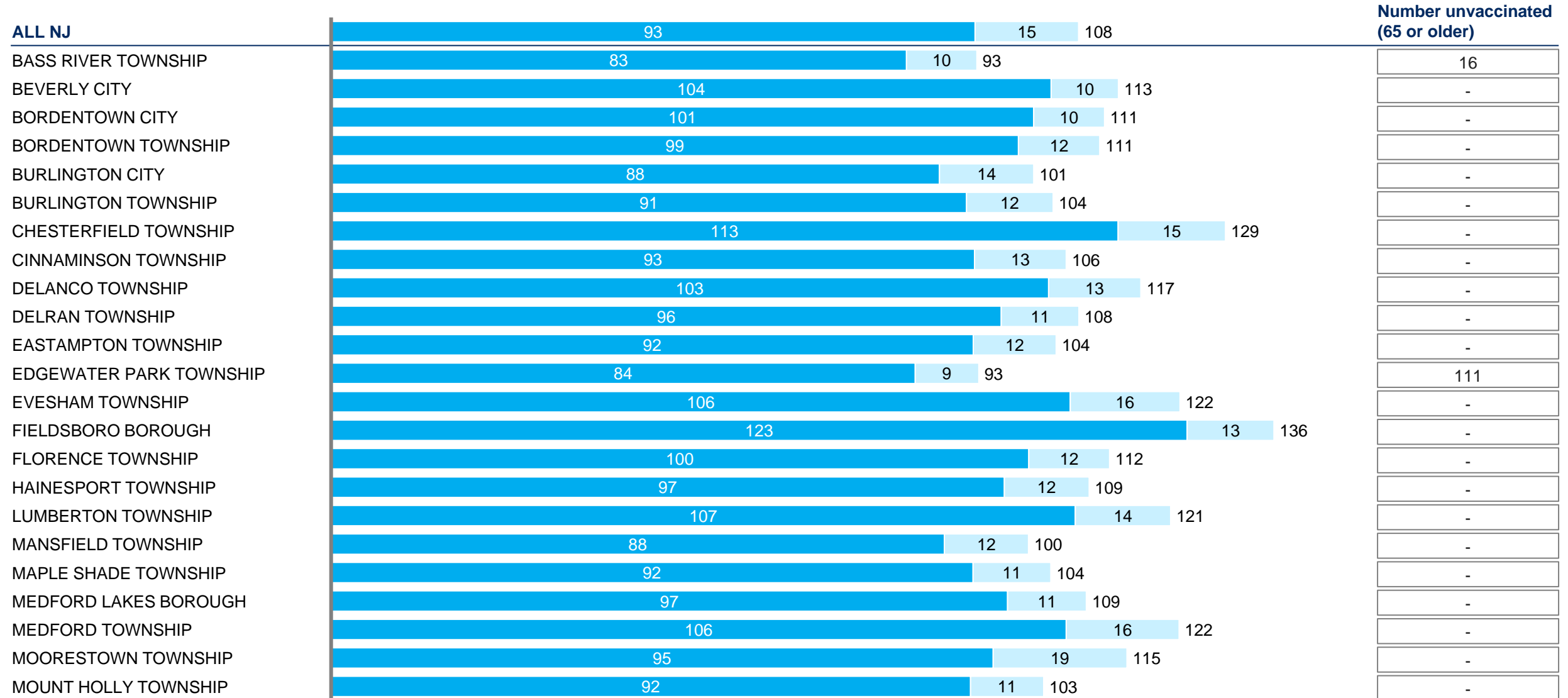

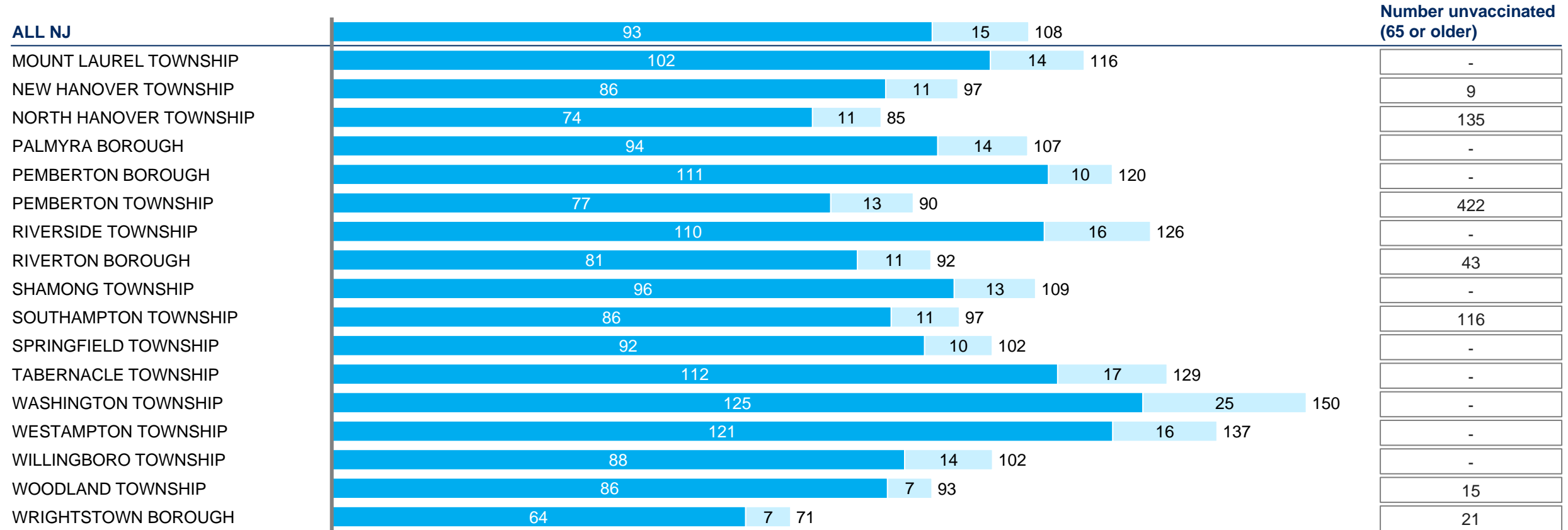
